

Tanguy Seiwert, MD, is director of the Head and Neck Cancer Program at The University of Chicago Medicine.

He received his medical degree at Johannes-Gutenberg University in Mainz, and completed an internship at Ruprecht-Karls University, Heidelberg, both in Germany. He also did an internship and residency at Duke University Medical Center in Durham, NC, and pursued research and oncology fellowships at The University of Chicago Medicine.

Dr Seiwert is a specialist in head and neck cancer, thyroid cancer, and salivary gland cancers and he has a special interest in genomic profiling, tumor immunology, and biomarker research.

Dr Seiwert is a member of the National Cancer Institute head and neck cancer steering committee. He is a fellow of the Institute for Genomics and Systems Biology at the University of Chicago, as well as a member of the head and neck cancer project of the Cancer Genome Atlas.
